ROTARY VOLUNTEERS PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- Rotarians, Rotaractors, Rotary Foundation alumni, and non-Rotarians may register as Rotary Volunteers. Volunteers are expected to have a proven level of professional or technical skill. Given the level of experience required, it is recommended that registrants be a minimum of 25 years of age. Rotary Volunteers is not an internship program.
- Your registration will be entered into the international volunteer database maintained at RI World Headquarters. You will need to re-register every two years to maintain an active status and to continue to receive current program information.
- With your permission, your name, contact information, and a brief description of your skills will be included in the searchable Rotary Volunteers Database on the RI Web site, www.rotary.org. Volunteer coordinators of Rotary projects and of other organizations may contact you in their search for volunteer assistance. Please indicate on this form if you wish to be included in the searchable database. (Note: The RV Web pages are accessible to the general public).
- Volunteers often pay their own travel and personal expenses or request contributions from their Rotary club, district, or other organizations. The host sponsor club(s) or organization(s) may sometimes pay for local accommodations (or offer home hospitality) or for a volunteer's working supplies and local transportation.
- Rotary Volunteers is an information network. The Rotary Volunteers program DOES NOT PLACE VOLUNTEERS OR MAKE ARRANGEMENTS. It is each volunteer's responsibility to correspond with a project site or organization and locate an appropriate placement. All contacts and arrangements must be made directly between you and the project coordinator.
